What is a haiku?

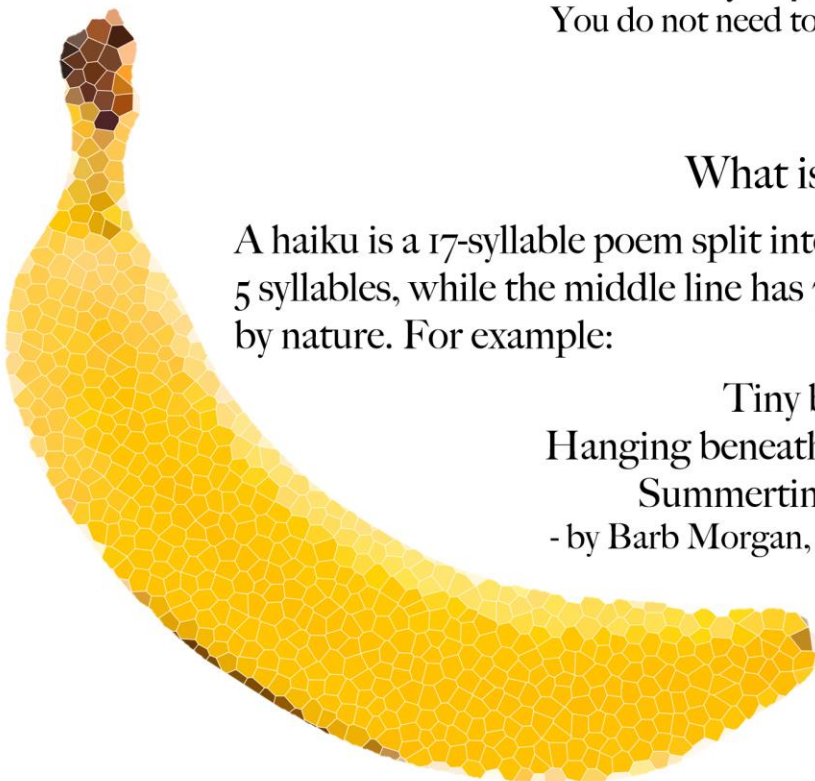

Summertime sweetness. (5)
